Report on Mobilization of NRNA Mobile Blood Bus after Handover (Magh to Chaitra 2080)

Introduction and Description: During the period from Magh to Chaitra 2080, the Nepal Red Cross Society Sunsari, Dhanusha and Banke District Chapter successfully mobilized the NRNA Mobile Blood Bus to facilitate blood collection across various provinces. The quarterly report indicates the following:

Koshi Province: Blood collection conducted by NRCS Sunsari District Chapter in Janakpur, Dhanusha amounted to 582 units, comprising 455 from males and 127 from females.

Madhesh Province: NRCS Dhanusha District Chapter, located in Dharan, Sunsari, contributed 457 units of blood, with 418 units collected from males and 39 units from females.

Lumbini Province: The NRCS Banke District Chapter, situated in Nepalgunj, Banke, achieved significant blood collection, totaling 851 units. This comprised 704 units from males and 147 units from females.

Total Collection: Across the three provinces, a combined total of 1,890 units of blood were collected during the specified period. This includes 1,577 units from males and 313 units from females.

The report demonstrates the proactive efforts of the Nepal Red Cross Society Sunsari, Dhansuwa and Banke District Chapters in collaborating with various chapters and utilizing mobile blood collection units to address the ongoing demand for blood donations. Such initiatives play a crucial role in ensuring a steady blood supply to meet the needs of patients and healthcare facilities.

The mobilization of the NRNA Mobile Blood Bus across different provinces reflects the commitment of Nepal Red Cross Society Sunsari, Dhansuwa and Banke District Chapters to ensure an adequate blood supply for medical emergencies. Those has shown commendable efforts in coordinating blood collection drives, particularly in Koshi Province, Dhanusha Province and Lumbini Province, where a substantial amount of blood was collected.
