## Frequently Asked Questions

1. Do I need to register for the conference even if I won't attend it in-person?

Ans: Yes, all conference attendees including scientific abstract presenters, program attendees, observers, online attendees, etc. need to register themselves for the conference. Please register at www.nrna.org/5ghnhc

2. Do I have to pay the conference registration fee?

Ans: No, the conference registration is free for everyone.

3. Where is the conference happening?

Ans: The physical location of the conference is at Tokyo Japan with full address as 1 chome-10-1 Nishi Shinjuku, Shinjuku City, Tokyo, Yodobashi Shinjuku Nishiguchi Ekimae Building. 8th floor.

4. Is it required to attend in person in Tokyo to participate in the conference?

Ans: While we encourage physical in-person participation as much as possible, it is not necessary to attend the conference in person. You can join the conference virtually as well.

5. Is there any funding available to apply for the conference?

Ans: We do not have any official logistic provision from the organizing committee of the conference. However, if anyone is interested in applying for the external funding opportunities, we would be happy to assist with necessary documents like an invitation letter.

6. Is the accommodation available for the in-person attendees?

Ans: We do not provide accommodation for the conference attendees. Hence, make sure to manage your trip by yourselves. You can search for some popular websites like agoda.com, booking.com, expedia.co.jp, etc. to manage your trip.

7. Will you sponsor the visa to attend the conference?

Ans: No, we won't be able to sponsor any type of visa for the conference however, we can forward the invitation letter upon reasonable request from the participants who are willing to attend the conference.
