



Non-Resident Nepali Association President's Report of July, 2023

The campaign of the Non-Resident Nepali Association more effective by strengthening the slogan "Nepali for Nepali" is continuing. In this regard, the Nepal government has already addressed the demand for 'Non-Resident Nepali Citizenship' raised by non-resident Nepali since 2003. Currently, the government is developing directives and procedures. The NRNA has been actively involved in continuous discussions and provided suggestions to the government regarding this matter. The association has always played a crucial role in fostering prosperity for Nepal and Nepali. In this regard, significant activities have been accomplished in the month of July. Here is a summary of the activities.

- On the 3rd of July, 2023, a delegation led by President Kul Acharya convened with the Honorable Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Home Affairs, Narayan Kaji Shrestha, at the Ministry of Home Affairs. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss crucial recommendations concerning the guidelines for Non-Resident Nepali citizenship. On the same day, the delegation engaged in meetings with several other authorities to further deliberate on matters pertaining to the guidelines for non-resident Nepali citizenship.
- On 6th July 2023, a delegation led by President Kul Acharya met with the Prime Minister Pushpakamal Dahal, urgently urging for the prompt implementation of the guidelines for Non-Resident Nepali citizenship. During this crucial meeting, Mr. Acharya emphasized the need to establish comprehensive rules and procedures governing the Citizenship Act to ensure its effective implementation.

- On 7th July 2023, President Kul Acharya participated in an interaction program organized by Ministry of Industry, Commerce, and Supplies. During the event, he emphasized the need to create an investment-friendly environment for Non-Resident Nepali and discussed the challenges they face in investing in Nepal.
- On July 7, 2023, President Kul Acharya also attended another interaction program organized by the Rastriya Swatantra Party. The discussions during this interaction revolved around topics such as Non-Resident Nepali citizenship, investment prospects in Nepal, and the prevailing challenges.
- On 9th July 2023, Vocational Education Committee under the Non-Resident Nepali Association organized a program, during this program, President Kul Acharya addressed the increasing demand for skilled labor in the international labor market and highlighted the importance of vocational training for Nepali workers going abroad for employment.
- On 9th July 2023, the 90th ICC meeting of the Non-Resident Nepali Association was held, Comprehensive discussions and decisions were made on matters concerning the ICC and NCC.
- On 23rd July 2023, President Rabina Thapa participated in the regional "Health Awareness and Counseling Program" organized by the Women's Division of the Non-Resident Nepali Association. She praised the program's effectiveness in raising awareness about health issues among Nepali, especially those in rural areas, and emphasized the potential of utilizing skills and knowledge gained abroad in Nepal's health sector.
- Throughout the month of July, from 1st to 31st, 2023, national conferences and elections were conducted for various National Coordination Committees. In this regard, Executive president Badri K.C, alongside the Presidents Kul Acharya and Rabina Thapa, extended their collective congratulations to the newly elected officials.
